MINUTES MERIDIAN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

Thursday, March 17, 2022 12:00 Noon

- 1. CALL TO ORDER AND PROOF OF POSTING. President Jerry Mobley called the meeting to order, and Garland read the proof of posting. Members present were Jerry Mobley, Paul Hardcastle, Michael Woerner, Fred Worthey, Ted Gebhardt, Michelle Kirby, and Marie Garland. Also present were Ashley Barner, Tom Schenck, and Nathan Diebenow.
- 2. CITIZEN PARTICIPATION, None
- 3. **MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING**. A motion was made by Hardcastle, seconded by Worthey, and carried to approve the minutes of the February meeting.
- 4. FINANCIAL STATEMENT AND PAYMENT OF BILLS. Garland reported a balance of \$529,070.40 in the checking. The bills presented for payment were reimbursement for the expenses at the Chisholm Trail Plaza in the amount of \$15,461.54 and \$243.56 for the set-up ad for Golden Taxidermy. A motion was made by Hardcastle, seconded by Gebhardt, and carried to approve the financial statement and bills.

5. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Golden Taxidermy Report of the ad in the Safari Magazine was given.
- B. **Plaza Update** Paul Hardcastle reported on the progress on the Chisholm Trail Plaza.
- C. **Day Care Center** Mobley reported that the day care center group was given the contact information for a building owner in town.

6. NEW BUSINESS

A. Bosque County Broadband Advisory Committee for broadband in Bosque County.

Tom Schenck and Nathan Diebenow gave a presentation on the lack of good broadband service in Bosque County. Mr. Schenck reported that the legislature created the Governor's Broadband Advisory Council under the Texas Comptroller. He reported that Bosque County needed to be ahead of the group and develop their own board so that we can determine what our county needs. Funds will be available

for those counties that have developed their needs. Mr. Schenck asked the Meridian EDC to write a letter of support to the Bosque County Judge and Commissioners supporting the development of a Bosque County Broadband Advisory Board. A motion was made by Woerner, seconded by Hardcastle, and carried to send a letter of support to Bosque County for the development of a Bosque County Broadband Advisory Council.

- B. Development of Maintenance Fund for EDC projects owned by the City of Meridian. Much discussion was had concerning the development of a maintenance fund for projects owned by the City of Meridian. Mobley explained that there was concern about the upkeep of the projects funded by MEDC and the need for a fund set aside for the City to tap into when needed. It was also suggested that instead of a fund being set up, that the City come back before the MEDC Board to request extra funds when needed. This item was tabled.
- C. Chamber of Commerce Dues. Members again reported that they did not want to submit the dues to the Meridian Chamber of Commerce until the Chamber came before the Board with a detailed plan and financial statements. Gebhardt mentioned that the Chamber was doing a lot more than what people think. A motion was made by Garland, seconded by Woerner, and carried to remove this from the agenda until the Chamber requested to be on the agenda.
- D. **LED Sign at Meridian Parks.** Fred Worthey presented the quotes he received for a LED information sign for the Meridian Park area. Quotes were received from Signature Signs in Whitney in the amounts of \$13,678.11 20mm, \$22,074.88 10mm, and \$26,095.00 8mm. Discussion was had concerning the differences in each sign. Other quotes were received but not presented at the meeting. Garland asked that the board be able to see each type of sign before committing any funds to it. A committee to review the signs and quotes was formed with Fred Worthey, Michael Woerner, Jerry Mobley, and Don Hatley serving. A motion was made by Worthey, seconded by Garland, and carried to appoint the committee and return with suggestions.

ADJOURN – There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

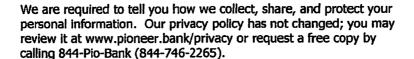

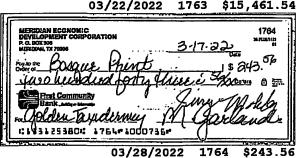
